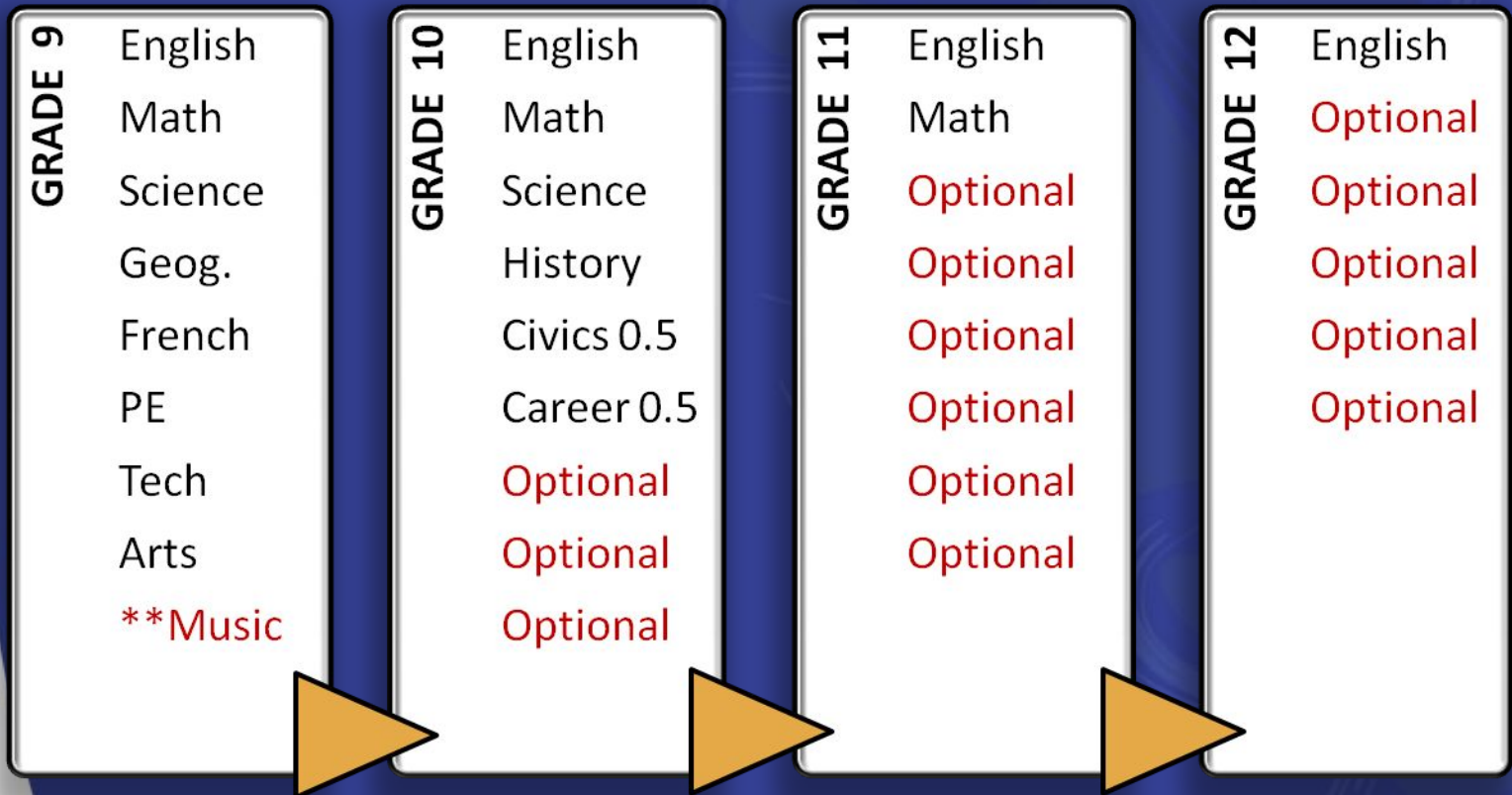
- 30 credits (110 hours each)

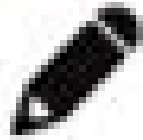
