- . The PRO (Parents Reaching Out) grant was approved for this year! Ann Douglas is holding tentative speaking dates in November for us. Approval is needed at the next meeting with new Council members.

7. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT – John Stieva

- . **Staffing** Staffing is difficult at the beginning of the year due to unexpected events. All teachers are set now for the 2015/2016 year. There are 172 staff on two campuses with an approximate enrollment of 1,900. The projected enrollment for 2016 is 2,000, 2017 (2,100), 2018 (2,200) and then down to 1,500 for 2019 when a new high school in North Oakville should be built. We have four Vice Principals; Paul Dawson and Kate Rehm on the North and Rasa Baksys and Elaine MacRae on the South.
- Capital Improvements A new ceiling was put in the South Cafeteria as well as some new banks of lockers, 400 new desks and chairs, and new doors and windows. Air conditioning is needed and hopefully will be installed next summer. A new theatre for WOSS is still being investigated. The creation of a marketing plan for the theatre will be a McMaster/Sheridan project in September.
- . **Sanctions** The OSSTF has ratified the Provincial portion of the agreement but are still negotiating at a local level. Currently, teachers are not attending Department or staff meetings. Extra-curricular activities are still going on.
- . Important Dates Honours Night (October 7th) and Commencement (October 8th)

8. TEACHER REPORT – Sara Belford

- . Sara explained her role as liaison between Council and the teachers.
- . The Terry Fox run will be September 30th during Period 1.

9. OTHER - Sherry Kirkham

- . Kelly Amos was unable to attend the meeting due to a hiring meeting for the Director position.
- . Sherry informed Council that the PIC Conference is the weekend of October 17th at White Oaks.
